

Directions from the South: Coming from SC, or in the Piedmont of NC, you have 2 choices. If you are closer to Interstate 77, go North until you reach Interstate 40 in Statesville. Follow I-40 East for approximately 40 miles, towards Winston-Salem, NC. Turn off onto Highway 52 North. Travel for approximately 22 miles, going through Winston-Salem. Take exit 129 and you will make a left at the top of the ramp, crossing back over HW-52 (follow the "camping" signs). Jomeokee campground is approximately 1 mile down on the right, just after the Marathon gas station. There is a white fence and gate and a sign for Jomeokee Park.

Alternate: If you are closer to Interstate 85, take 85 North, looking for Highway 52 North, at exit 87. Important: HW-52 North is above the exit for HW-52 South, so don't get off on the South exit and try to turn around. Look at your map for guidance. Travel for approximately 42 miles, passing through Winston-Salem. Take exit 129 and make a left at the top of the ramp, crossing back over HW-52 (follow the "camping" signs). Jomeokee campground is approximately 1 mile down on the right, just after the Marathon gas station. There is a white fence and gate and a sign for Jomeokee Park.

Directions from the West: Coming from TN, or in the Asheville area of NC, you will take Interstate 40 East, passing over I-77 near the Statesville/Hickory area towards Winston-Salem. Follow I-40 East for approximately 40 miles after crossing I-77. Turn off onto Highway 52 North. Travel for approximately 22 miles, you are looking for Exit 129. Take the exit and look for the "camping" signs, crossing back over HW-52. Jomeokee campground is approximately 1 mile down on the right, just after the Marathon gas station. There is a white fence and gate and a sign for Jomeokee Park.

Directions from the North: Depending on where you are coming from you have 2 choices if you want to follow Interstates.

From the NorthEast: Follow Interstate 85 South. Continue on I-85 South as it merges with Interstate 40 (I-85/40) towards Greensboro. When the interstate splits take I-40 West towards Winston-Salem. Turn off onto Highway 52 North. Travel for approximately 22 miles, you are looking for Exit 129 on HW-52. Take the exit and look for the "camping" signs. Jomeokee campground is approximately 1 mile down on the right, just after the Marathon gas station. There is a white fence and gate and a sign for Jomeokee Park.

From the NorthWest: Depending on which area you are coming from, you can take Interstate 77 South and get on Highway 52 South or simply use your map to find the best point to get onto HW-52 South. It is also possible to come down the Blue Ridge Parkway if you want a nice scenic drive, and take the HW-52 South exit. The campground is directly off of HW-52, approximately 22 miles North of Winston-Salem, NC. You are looking for exit 129 on HW-52. Take the exit and look for the "camping" signs. Jomeokee campground is approximately 1 mile down on the right, just after the Marathon gas station. There is a white fence and gate and a sign for Jomeokee Park.

From the East or Greensboro/Raleigh-Durham area: Follow Interstate 85 South/40 West towards Winston-Salem. When the interstates split follow I-40 West towards Winston-Salem, and take the exit for Highway 52 North. Travel for approximately 22 miles North on HW-52, you are looking for Exit 129. Take the exit and look for the "camping" signs, crossing back over HW-52. Jomeokee campground is approximately 1 mile down on the right, just after the Marathon gas station. There is a white fence and gate and a sign for Jomeokee Park.
